

Hayat Programs expanded its scope to establish the Hayat Foundation in the 2024-25 session. Diverging from a traditional focus on health and education, the department is now dedicated to initiating innovative programs that address a broader spectrum of societal needs.

While building upon the foundation laid by the Operation Team, Hayat Programs is committed to fostering long-term impact. A prime example is the Mental Health Well-being domain. initiative seeks to create a comprehensive support for individuals encountering life's system challenges, with a particular emphasis on those with mental struggling health issues. By prioritizing emotional well-being over financial concerns, we aim to empower individuals to overcome obstacles and lead fulfilling lives.

ORGANIZATIONAL COMMITTEE

HF (Hayat Foundation) is currently implementing programs in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Province. The organization is expanding its operations to Punjab and Islamabad Capital Territory to extend its reach and impact. The operation departments include 02 sub-divisions and 01 independent department;

- 1. Hayat-e-Ilm
- 2. Hayat-e-Sehat
- 3. Hayat Programs







Each of Hayat Foundation's three teams is structured with a Director, Assistant Director, and general members. The leadership positions of Director and Assistant Director are appointed by the organization's Cabinet and Board of Governors. General members are chosen by the Director and Cabinet.

Team responsibilities encompass a broad spectrum of activities aimed at addressing critical social needs. These include:

- Social welfare: Providing financial and psychological support to orphanages, individuals with disabilities, and the elderly.
- Healthcare: Addressing healthcare disparities through medical camps in rural areas, financial assistance for indigent patients, and support for marriage-related expenses for underprivileged families.
- Economic empowerment: Implementing programs designed to enhance employment opportunities within Pakistan.
- Community engagement: Conducting fundraising campaigns and organizing seminars and webinars to raise awareness about social issues and mobilize community support.

HAYAT-E-ILM

Hayat-e-Ilm is concerned about severe education crisis like the old school curriculum, characterised by low literacy rates, inadequate infrastructure, and a shortage of qualified teachers. These challenges are exacerbated by factors such as poverty, child labor, and regional disparities. The consequences of such crisis are far-reaching thereby, hindering economic growth, social development, and the overall well-being of the nation.

To address this pressing issue, Hayat-e-Ilm focuses on various aspects of education, including early childhood development, primary and secondary education, teacher training, and vocational skills development.



VISION

To create a Pakistan where every child has equal access to quality education and is equipped to reach their full potential.

MISSION

To empower communities through education by providing comprehensive, accessible, and sustainable education programs that foster critical thinking, lifelong learning, and positive social change.

KPK faces significant challenges in the field of education. Low school enrollment, particularly among girls, is prevalent. A shortage of qualified teachers and inadequate infrastructure, compounded by security concerns, hinder educational progress in the region.

Despite being Pakistan's most populous province, **Punjab** grapples with education disparities. Overcrowded classrooms, a shortage of teachers, and limited early childhood education facilities are common issues. The rapid pace of urbanization and the persisting rural-urban divide exacerbate these challenges

Islamabad, while comparatively better off, experiences its education-related problems. Rapid population growth has strained educational resources, leading to overcrowded schools. Additionally, the gap between affluent and underprivileged areas within the capital creates inequalities in access to quality education.



Hayat-e-Sehat is a severe healthcare crisis characterised by limited access to quality healthcare, particularly in rural areas. A shortage of medical professionals, inadequate infrastructure, and the high cost of treatment contribute to poor health outcomes, these have also been observed to the major concerns. Infectious diseases, maternal and child mortality, and malnutrition remain significant challenges.

To address these pressing issues, Hayat-e-Sehat is working tirelessly to improve healthcare access and delivery. We are also focused on preventive care, health education, and capacity building for local healthcare providers. By collaborating with government agencies and communities, Hayat-e-Sehat always tries to play a vital role in enhancing healthcare services and improving the overall health and well-being of the population.

MISSION

Provision of the Fundamental Right to equality, health and well-being

Hayat-e-Sehat is a crucial organisation addressing healthcare and social issues in Pakistan. They establish clinics, train healthcare workers, and conduct medical camps in rural areas to provide essential healthcare services.

Additionally, Hayat-e-Sehat supports vulnerable groups such as orphans, disabled individuals, and the elderly through financial and psychological assistance. The organisation also addresses issues like insufficient funds for poor patients, promotes employment opportunities, and raises awareness through seminars and webinars to improve the overall well-being of Pakistani communities.

HAYAT PROGRAMS

Hayat Program is a project of the Hayat Foundation and mental health well-being domain working under this project, we aim to establish a platform for individuals in our society grappling with daily life issues, particularly focusing on mental well-being rather than financial concerns.

Mental Health Well-being

This is an online platform which aims to address the pressing need within our society for mental health support.

We felt that the people in our society need such types of platforms so we designed the mental health well-being project to promote mental health and well-being by offering resources, support, and strategies to enhance psychological resilience and overall mental wellness.

- The resources provided will include: Webinars, online sessions, workshops, online orientation and in future physical seminars or conferences and also other training sessions.
- Additionally, we will offer online support services: Client can take consult and sessions from mental health professionals (therapists, counsellors, and psychologists) directly through our online platform at a very low and affordable rate.
- Clients, individuals or students will have the opportunity to engage in online training sessions anyhow we will make mental health support easily accessible.


